NYMPHENBURG PALACE

ROYAL RESIDENZ

Include in your Munich city tour an inside visit in Nymphenburg palace. With its extensive palace park and the large driveway avenue, it served the Bavarian rulers of the House Wittelsbach, as a summer residence and is one of the largest and most beautiful royal palaces in Europe.

One of the big attractions in Munich and the largest city palace of any German city. The delightful atmosphere transports the visitors to a different time as they walk through the ball rooms, concert hall and interiors. The Munich Residence served as the seat of government and residence of the Bavarian dukes, electors and kings from 1508 to 1918, today one of the most important palace museums in Europe.

The Kunstareal offers an extraordinary diversity of museums with works ranging from Ancient Egypt, Classical Greco-Roman, Old Masters up to the present. A total of 18 museums and exhibition halls, 20 galleries, six renowned international colleges and countless cultural institutions are all in the immediate vicinity, easily accessible by foot. This cultural tour around Kunstareal takes you wandering among countless architectural and cultural highlights:

OLYMPIC ROOF WALK

Munich is famous for its traditional, mouthwatering foods. Soak up the romantic atmosphere while strolling through the quaint streets of Old Town Munich and visit the 200-year-old Viktualienmarkt local food market. At the end of the tour - depending on the weather - you will visit a beer garden or a traditional restaurant together you will also have the opportunity to eat here. The tour ends at the Hofbräuhaus.
